Maximum length: one page; **line spacing:** 1.5; **font:** Times New Roman; **content:** Page 1: title, abstract, and keywords. Page 2: author's name, affiliation(s), email, phone number, and postal address

- Deadline for Abstract Submission: February 15, 2012 (Wednesday)
- Notification of Abstract Acceptance: March 5, 2012 (Monday)
- Deadline for Full Paper Submission: August 31, 2012 (Friday)

Submission Details:

- ♦ Abstracts: Submission by email only, to: hrlin@fcu.edu.tw
- ♦ Full Papers: Email submission plus hard copy via postal mail. Papers should be no longer than 15 pages (including illustrations, tables, charts, etc. and references/sources).
- ♦ The organizing committee will send each abstract in anonymous form to a specialist in the abstract's topic for evaluation.
- ♦ Paper Format: APA or MLA; Paper size: A4; Margins: top & bottom: 2.54; left & right: 3.17; Font: Times New Roman 12; Titles/headlines/captions: size 14, bold; Spacing: single spacing.
- ♦ Publishing details: All accepted papers will be published in book form (with an ISBN number) or as a CD.
