Mikasa: It's a deal.

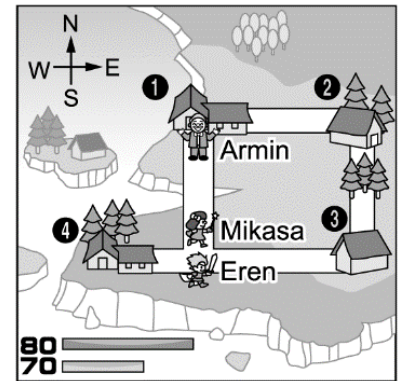


